## **Note to the Teacher**

Prior to your excursion to Brownes Dairy, we encourage you to share one or more of the following activities with your class. The activities below represent a sample and there is no requirement to complete all activities.

- Show and discuss the class the Map of Brownes Dairy Factory. Explain each area that they will be visiting on the day.
- Collect magazine pictures to make a collage of milk and milk products.
- Read stories about farm animals, specifying dairy animals, or life on a farm. There are a number of children's picture books which could be used as springboards to explore aspects of Dairy farms.
- Use the whiteboard or other digital devices at the school to read e-Books and introduce the students to Dairy cows, dairy farms and the people who raise Dairy cows and produce milk
- Read the stories for information about farms as places where lots of animals, including Dairy cows, are raised.

Ask students to:

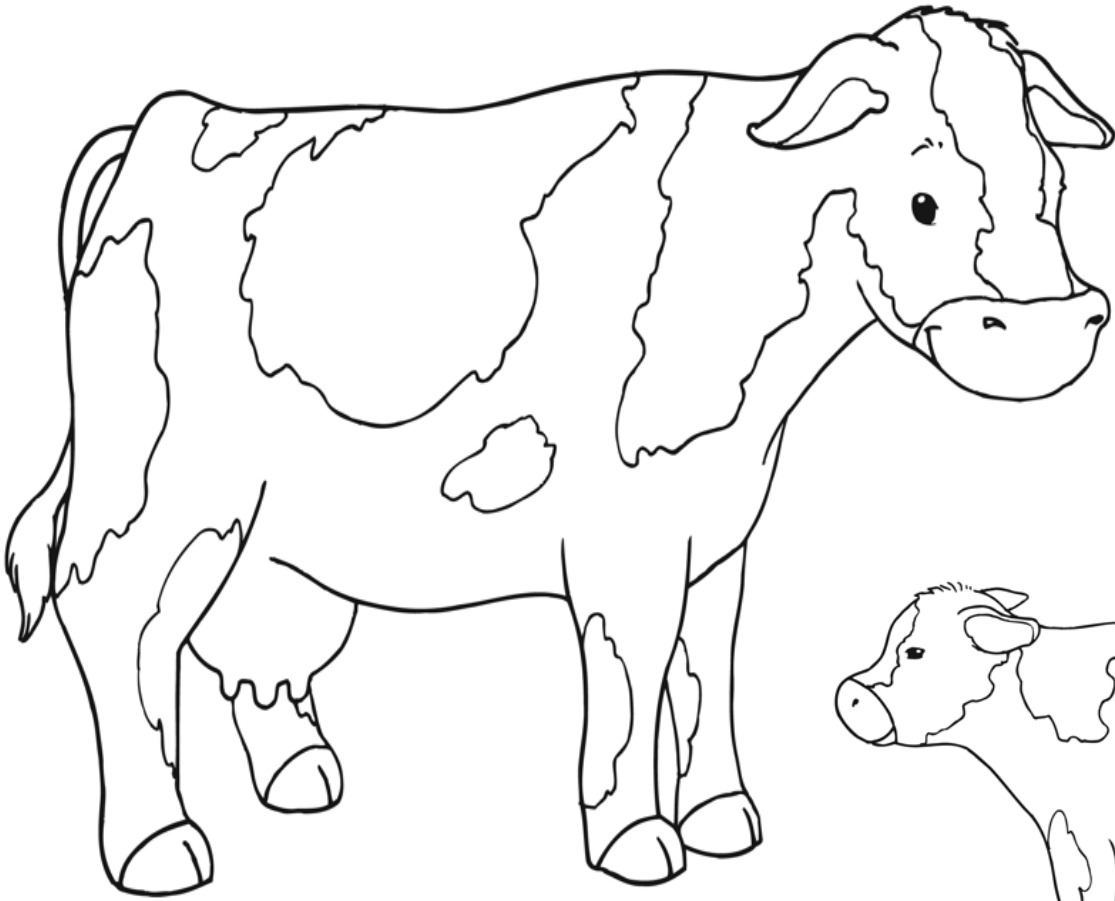
- interpret illustrations;
  - talk about what is happening and where it is happening;
  - identify where the farm animals are in the illustrations and discuss this;
  - ask questions about the farm animals or places on the farms in the story;
  - tell a story using picture clues; and
  - record favourite places in a story and write captions.
- Conduct an activity in which students draw a picture of a Dairy farm, including the various activities.
  - Identify and discuss the roles of family members in a home. Everybody has important jobs to help their family (example: adults cook food or shop, children help with looking after animals).
  - Students to use empty milk container or cartons and yoghurt containers to create a Dairy farm scene.

## **Post Excursion Activities**

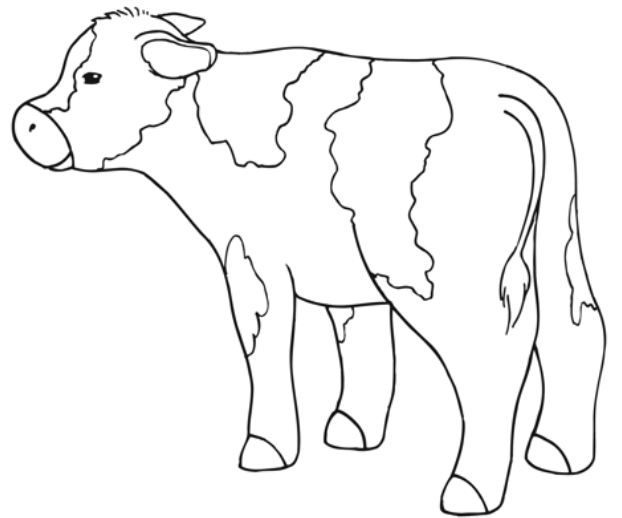
- Compose and send a class thank you letter to Brownes Dairy and the Dairy farmer. Include student artwork, illustrations, work samples, drawings and tell us what your favourite part.
- Story maps.
- Have students draw or paint (teacher to scribe) what the students learnt or favourite part at Brownes Dairy Factory Tour.
- Create a class story, poem, class book, report using technology to create multimedia presentations.
- Place an excursion recount article in the school's newsletter.
- Class excursion photograph display in the classroom.
- Dairy cooking activity.
- Dress up day as a Dairy farmer.
- Create a class book about the Brownes Dairy excursion.
- Student self-reflection.
- Recount
- Class cooking day including dairy products.
- Make a class favourite milk recipe book.
- Explore further topics on recycling at school, home, and the community.
- Integrate agriculture into the Health and nutrition lessons.
- Investigate jobs in agriculture.
- Use recycle milk bottles, cartons and yoghurt containers to create a dairy farm

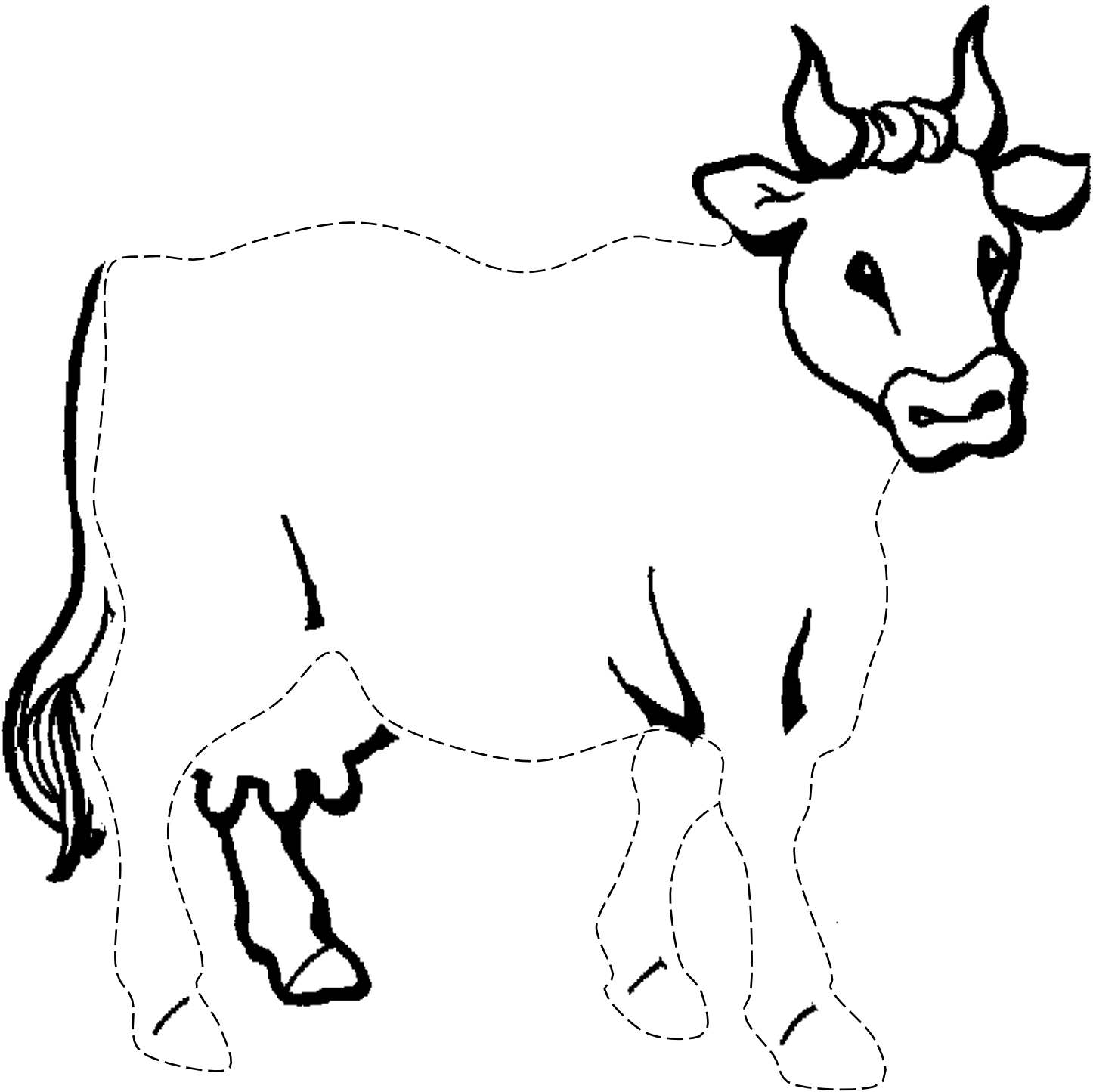

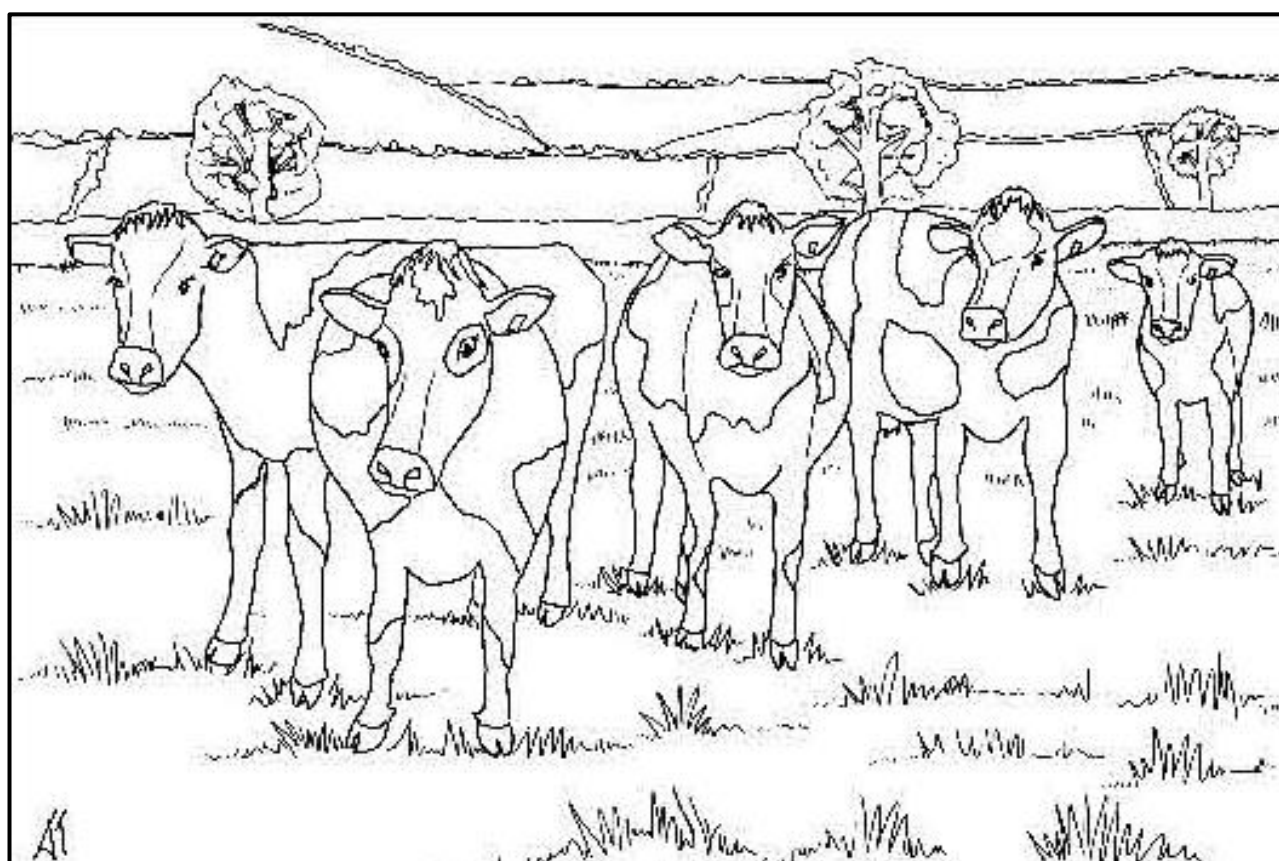

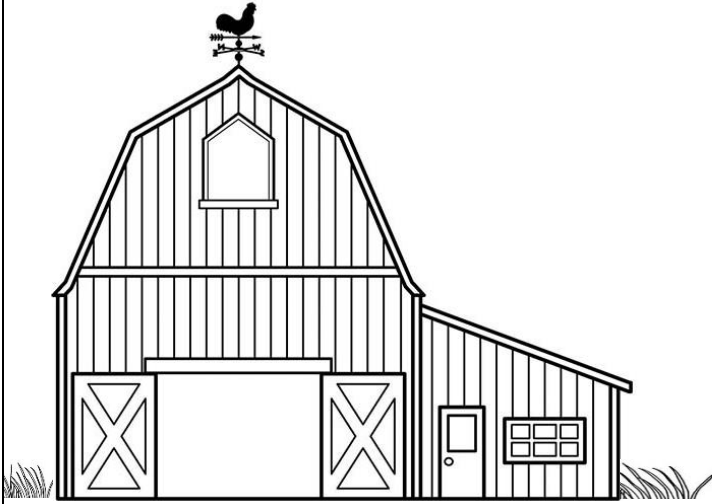

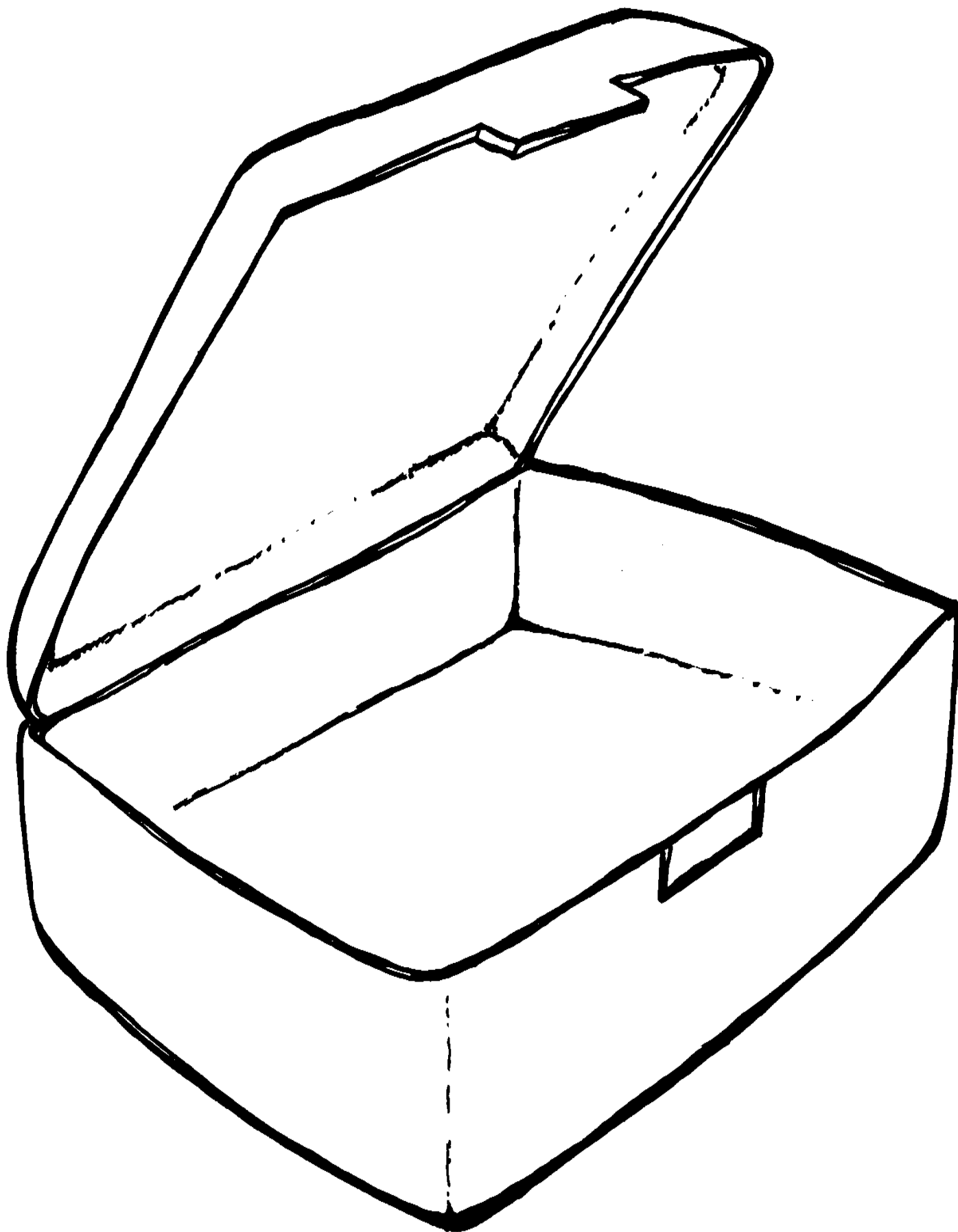


## Life of a Dairy Farmer

Draw a Dairy Farmer feeding the cows at his Dairy farm. Make sure that you include the following: clothing, hat, boots and the cows eating farm food.

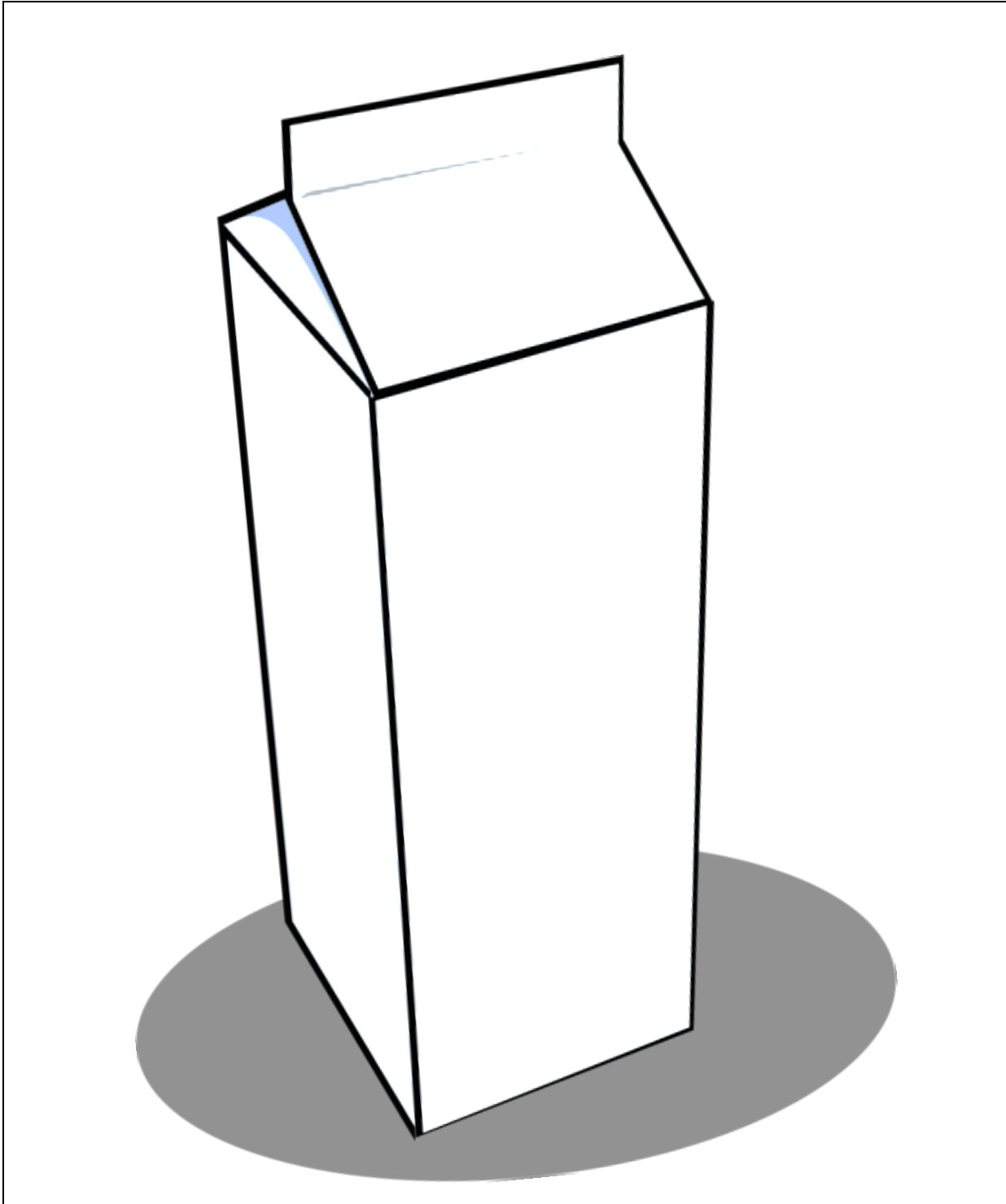

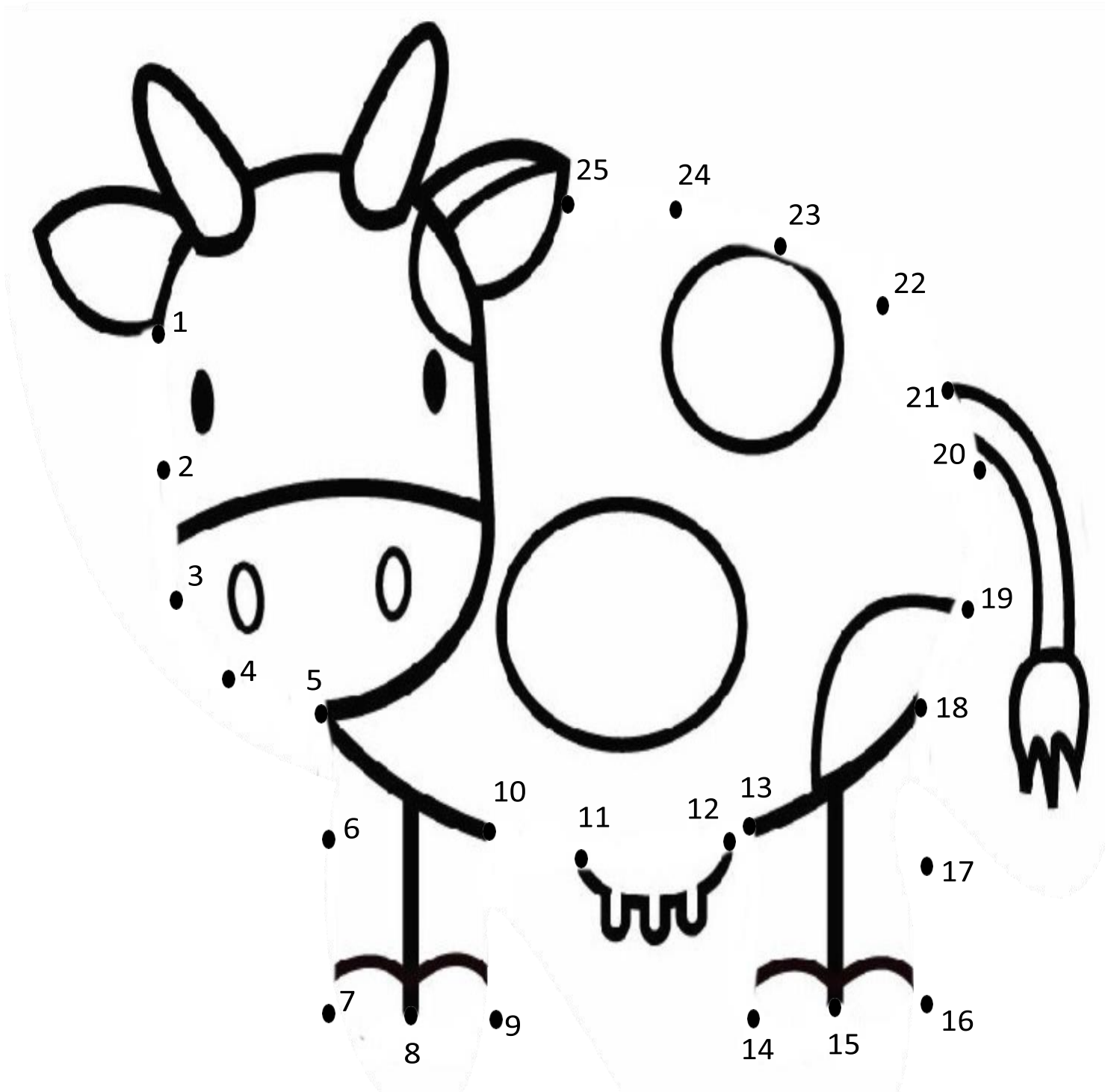

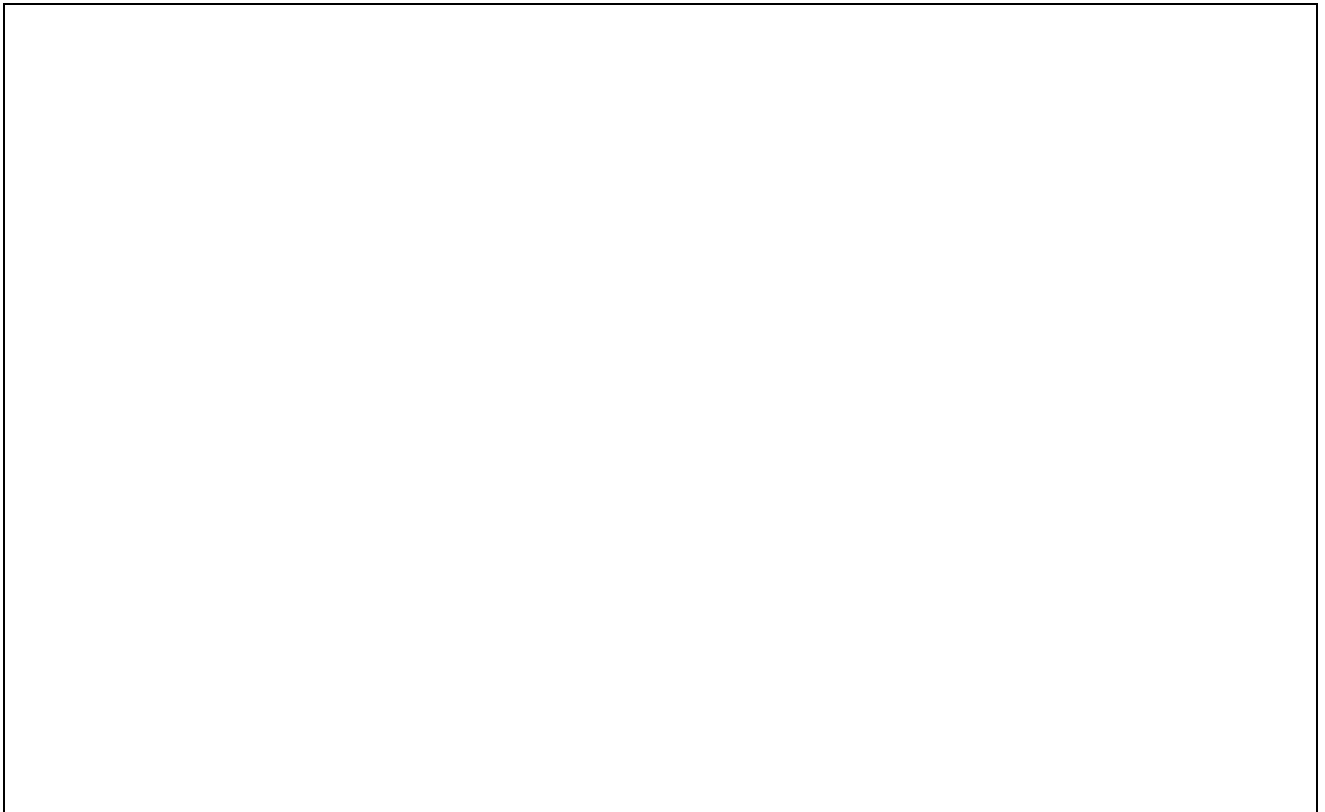
